



Theatre Arts Advanced Honors Enrollment Application

Prerequisites: In order to apply for the advanced honors class, you need to have completed theatre arts beginning, theatre arts intermediate, and theatre arts proficient. There are only two exceptions to this rule: 1) you are a transfer student—in which the instructor will review the courses you have taken to determine eligibility, and 2) block scheduling somehow prohibits a student from completing the sequence in four years at Green Hope. In the second exception, a student must provide written evidence of the scheduling discrepancy in order to be considered for eligibility—the second exception must be approved by both the instructor and the dean of students.

Your application is due on the day of your scheduled audition. You must schedule an audition via the Signup Genius—which can be found on the Green Hope Theatre Website: www.greenhopetheatre.weebly.com.

On the day of your audition, you must have a monologue prepared from a contemporary play. The monologue must be 1-2 minutes in length.
